



Gilmore students in engineering program

A GROUP of select Gilmore College students has earned a place in the Kwinana Industries Council (KIC) Metals and Engineering School Based Traineeship program which could pave the way to a long career.

Places in the program are competitive with 14 students named for 2012 at a ceremony in Kwinana last week.

The full-time students will complete one day a week at the Challenger Institute of Technology and spend blocks of time in work placements with member companies of KIC.
